INTRODUCTION

This recreational dance school began in 1987 with the idea of providing a centre where children could learn the poise and grace that dance brings in a caring & nurturing environment. I aim to develop deportment, confidence, a love of dance and the value of "team work" through dance, basic principles of movement and an appreciation of theatre without the pressure of exams, Eisteddfods and lavish concerts. I am fully qualified as a Licentiate under the CBA in the Cecchetti Ballet Method and currently hold a CBA Cert IV in Workplace Training & Assessment with Cecchetti Ballet Australia. I am a member of Cecchetti International Classical Ballet and also a Life Member CBA. I hope your child will find his/her dance classes interesting and enjoyable.

VENUES

Nth Narrabeen Community & Tennis Centre, 2 Woorarra Ave, Nth Narrabeen (Approach the centre via Rickard Road.)

PARENTS

Are not permitted to enter the class (with the exception of Kreative Kindy). At the end of Term One and Term Two parents will be invited to watch their child's dance class.

GROOMING

(Ballet and Contemporary) I hope you will encourage your child to attend class in the dance schools uniform with correct footwear. Girls should have hair neatly secured in a bun (with a bun cover) or pony tail (with a ribbon). All students should have clean shoes tied firmly and a smiling face, which creates a healthy attitude to dance. No Sloppy Joes, T-shirts or Track suit pants. During winter a crossover may be worn the colour of the leotard or tutu. Please put your name on anything you bring to your dance classes.

FEES

Are due and payable during the first two weeks of each term. Fees can be handed to Jenny in an envelope with your child's name, class and amount written on the front or post to P.O. Box 116, Narrabeen, 2101. All cheques payable to Jenny's School of Dance. Your receipt will be mailed to you. Should you wish to make alternative arrangements for payment phone Jenny 9975 4316 prior to the commencement of each term. Late fees other than by arrangement will incur a \$20 handling fee to cover the labour of extra bookwork. Envelopes for payment are in the foyer. Note: Bank Transfer Available

CLASSES

When classes have 5 or less students in attendance a further fee of \$25 per term (calculated on a one hour class) will be added to the term fee.

CONCERT

A Concert will be held in November at the Smith Auditorium, North Sydney 2.00 p.m. Your child has the option to participate in the concert, but a commitment to your decision would be appreciated. A Dress Rehearsal will be held at the same venue on a weekday after 4.00 p.m. the week prior to the concert. Costumes will be kept as practical as possible, some will be hired to you and others sold to you. A deposit for your costumes will be required at the end of Term Two. The balance to be paid the week before the concert.

TOILET

Please make every effort to take your child to the toilet before class begins. The toilet is located at the rear of the building and can be accessed via the pathway opposite the Main Hall front foyer door.

AWARDS

During the year Merit Awards are given in the school age classes. During the year a record is kept of attendance, grooming and effort in the Primary to Senior Classes. At the concert a class award is given to the most outstanding class from Primary to Senior Ballet or Contemporary Dance. Individual encouragement awards are recognised from Grade Two onwards in all styles of dance. New 4D award for one junior & one senior student (dedication, drive, discipline and desire)
